# **Avon Lake Water Main Improvements**

Weekly Construction Update

The intent of this weekly update is to give an overview of where construction has been, and where it should be in the next week. It is intended to be a general overview and be tentative in nature. Things may differ from the listed schedule if weather or other unknown factors come into play.



#### Weekly Overview:

#### April 4<sup>th</sup> – April 8<sup>th</sup>

- This week, J&K continued installing 12-inch water main pipe along SE Avon Drive/NE 1<sup>st</sup> Street. Connections were made to bored pipe and fire hydrants installed.
- J&K's second crew made connections for bored pipe and installed fire hydrants and valves. It is estimated 20% of connections are completed.
- Ground Effects Directional Drilling installed new 6-inch water main pipe on SE Maple Dr and 12-inch main along SE 66th Place, SE 68<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and in the City Park. This completes installation of all bored pipe.
- Ground Effects Directional Drilling has completed their work and de-mobilized from the project.

### What to expect next week: April 11<sup>th</sup> – April 15<sup>th</sup>

#### **Monday-Friday**

- J&K will continue to install 12-inch water main between City Park connection and North River.
- J&K, second crew, will continue connecting segments of installed 12-inch water main pipe and/or 6inch water main and installing fire hydrants.
- See below for locations of traffic restrictions for work by J&K.

## What you need to know

- Expect possible continued traffic restriction in intersection of SE 68<sup>th</sup> Ave & SE 55<sup>th</sup> Court.
- Expect work in intersections of SE Maple Dr & SE 55<sup>th</sup> Street, SE 66<sup>th</sup> Place & SE 55<sup>th</sup> Street, and SE 66<sup>th</sup> Place & SE Circle Drive.
- Expect a traffic disruption at SE Circle Drive and NE 1<sup>st</sup> Street later in week.
- Please utilize construction signage to know what is closed and what is open and which way to drive. Vehicular traffic should use other routes of access during this time. Pedestrian traffic and Local traffic (if you live in the area of construction) should use caution in construction areas. Please also obey personnel who are directing traffic during construction to help keep everyone safe.
- GARBAGE/RECYCLING PICK-UP -
  - Please put garbage and recycling out as you would normally, however, please use bags to allow sanitation crews better ability to pick up garbage in the construction zones.
- At this time, the post office will continue to deliver mail to your mailbox.
