# **Avon Lake Water Main Improvements**

# Weekly Construction Update

The intent of this weekly update is to give an overview of where construction has been, and where it should be in the next week. It is intended to be a general overview and be tentative in nature. Things may differ from the listed schedule if weather or other unknown factors come into play.



#### Weekly Overview:

# March 14th - March 18th

- This week, J&K installed 1,600 feet of 12-inch water main along Avon Drive.
- EBI (doing the trenchless drilling) drilled their "pilot hole" across North River to make a path to pull the new 12-inch water main from the north side of the river to the south side.

March 21st - March 25th What to expect next week:

## **Monday-Friday**

- J&K will continue to install 12-inch water main along Avon Drive.
- EBI will pull the 12-inch water main pipe across North River.
- EBI plans to directionally drill the 12-inch water main in North Park and under N 1st Street.
- EBI plans to drill the 12-inch water main under SE 60<sup>th</sup> Street once the river and park work is done.
- If there is still time left next week, EBI will begin work drilling the 12-inch main along SE 68<sup>th</sup> Place.
- A second crew from EBI will be drilling in 6-inch water main along SE 66th Place, beginning at the east end (by the RR tracks) and working west.
- A second crew from J&K will follow EBI, connecting services as the project works west along SE 66<sup>th</sup> Place.

## What you need to know

- Please utilize construction signage to know what is closed and what is open and which way to drive. Vehicular traffic should use other routes of access during this time. Pedestrian traffic and Local traffic (if you live in the area of construction) should use caution in construction areas. Please also obey personnel who are directing traffic during construction to help keep everyone safe.
- GARBAGE/RECYCLING PICK-UP -
  - Please put garbage and recycling out as you would normally, however, please use bags to allow sanitation crews better ability to pick up garbage in the construction zones.
- At this time, the post office will continue to deliver mail to your residence.
